

As you are no doubt aware all formal Covid-19 related restrictions that were enforceable by law in England have been lifted with effect from today. HM Government, however, continues to advise proceeding with caution – certainly for the present.

Functions apart the Summer period is one of relatively low activity in the club with reduced opening hours and significantly fewer members and visitors using the facilities. With this in mind, for the ongoing protection of staff, members and visitors, it has been decided that for general opening we will continue to apply our existing infection prevention measures. These will remain in place until a full review is carried out ahead of the start of the new season.

In summary this means that:

- individuals attending the clubhouse are requested to check-in using the QR code and NHS Covid App
- regular handwashing and sanitising continues to be encouraged
- we will encourage and maximise opportunities for outdoor service
- table service only continues - so no ordering at the bar and no standing to drink
- face masks to be worn in the clubhouse except when seated to eat and/or drink
- maintain current recommendations on social distancing
- ensure maximum ventilation of the clubhouse - so members need to be prepared for some potentially draughty sessions
- arrangements for functions will be handled on their merits - clients will be advised of our standard operating arrangements but we will be open to discussion based on the type of function and client wishes
