

Bar Notice: Covid-19 Restrictions Update
Local Restrictions Effective from Midnight 30/09/2020

We are very grateful to members who, whilst observing the various requirements and advice around limiting transmission of the Covid-19 virus, have continued to support bar activity over recent times. We re-open for business on Sunday 3 October following our short temporary closure. The local restrictions that became effective at midnight on Wednesday 30 September have an inevitable impact on how we can conduct business and the main changes you can expect to see while these measures remain in force are set out below:

- Gary, Kerry and the bar team will all be wearing face visors or masks
- Table service only for all food and drink – no ordering at the bar
- Face masks must be worn at all times except when actively eating or drinking (unless the person falls into an exempt category)
- All food and drink must be consumed seated at a table – inside or out
- You can only sit with your own household (i.e. the people you live with) or support bubble
- Groups involving more than one household/support bubble not allowed inside and should not be admitted
- Groups of over 6 people or more than one household/support bubble are not allowed outdoors
- Groups/households must respect social distancing – tables at least 2m apart inside and out and social distancing between individuals
- Groups/households cannot merge or mingle
- For people who have downloaded the NHS Covid-19 App the club QR code will be available for you to scan and “check-in”

These requirements are now legally enforceable and failure to comply leaves both the individual and the club at risk of official sanction. Please respect staff and others who might feel a need to remind anyone who suffers a temporary lapse of memory and be aware that staff have been mandated by the club to refuse service to anyone who persistently fails to comply.
